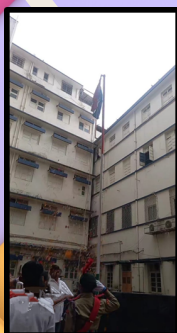


THE GREEN CLUB

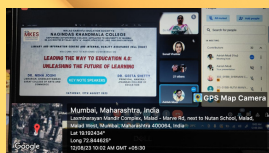

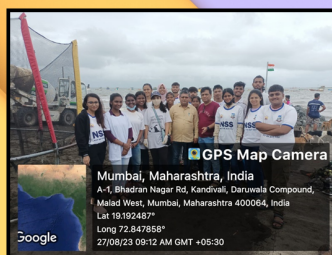
