Also, the Chairman informed that we would continue the present pattern of 75-25 for U.G. and 60-40 for P.G.

The Director of Education informed that it is possible to change the title of the paper, provided intimation should reach the University of Mumbai, Joint Director of Education and Director of Education, Pune.
