## 2) <u>To form rules regarding admission of students, subject to government rules</u> and regulations on admission procedure.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 5**

Resolved that the rules for admission for academic year 2018-19 will be based on three criterias only i.e. Minority, Open and Management quota. There is also a newly passed judgement by the court in this regard.

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It was further resolved that all the other rules of the University / State Government will be complied thereof.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 6**

Resolved that an Equivalence Committee shall be formed for admission purpose for the students of the other colleges / state taking admission in second and third year. All the students newly admitted will have to earn 8 extra credits.

 <u>To initiate measures for improving the quality of teaching, frame rules for</u> <u>conduct of examinations, rules of students evaluation and develop student</u> <u>advisory programmes.</u>

The recommendations of Board of Examination was accepted by the Academic Board and the following resolutions were passed unanimously <u>RESOLUTION NO. 7</u>

Resolved that

- 1. For UG programs (75 25 pattern), Internal Assessment (25%) is applicable for all courses; this includes class tests, projects and viva, assignments and viva, book review and group discussion etc.
- 2. Moderation Criteria for F.Y / S.Y

20% of total number of students appeared shall be moderated

3. Moderation criteria for T.Y

Marks	No. of Ans. Books
0 – 20	10%
21 – 30	ALL
31 - 44	20%
45 and Above	ALL

- 4. For F.Y and S.Y classes, a learner can apply for revaluation in any subject without the condition of marks.
- For T.Y classes, to make it more transparent, answer books will be shown to all students with proper arrangement.
- 6. For PG programs (60 40 pattern), Internal Assessment (40%) is applicable for all courses; this includes class tests, research projects, presentation and viva, assignments and viva, book review and group discussion etc.
- 7. For P.G programs, double evaluation procedure started from this academic year.

If there is a difference of 15% of total marks appeared between two evaluators, then third evaluation is applicable. The average between two nearest marks will be awarded to student.

- 8. Gracing procedure: As per the university ordinances.
- 4) <u>To make rules regarding extra credits for sports, extra-curricular activities,</u> <u>proper maintenance and functioning of the building, libraries, laboratories,</u> <u>etc.</u>

There was a discussion in the meeting to encourage students to participate in sports and cultural activities at the University level. It was decided to award 2 credits to the students winning in sports and cultural activities at University / State / National level.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 8**

Resolved that the students winning prizes in the cultural and sports events at the University / state level will be awarded 2 credits.

5) <u>To recommend to the Board of Management to institute scholarships</u>, <u>fellowships, studentships, medals, prizes, certificates and frame rules for the</u> <u>award of the same</u>. There was a discussion held in the meeting to offer scholarships to deserving students. Hence, after discussion it was decided to recommend to the management to earmark Rs.5,00,000/- for scholarships. Principal informed the members that Shri Nareshbhai Khandwala had donated Rs.1,00,000/- as Scholarships to the needy and economically backward class students. The committee expressed their sincere thanks to Shri Nareshbhai Khandwala for his generous donation of conveying his vision and purpose to expand the educational horizon of the student community.

## 6) <u>To advise the Board of Management on matters pertaining to the academic</u> affairs.

The Convenor of the Curriculum Enrichment Committee communicated that 15 new short term courses will be introduced for the academic year 2018-2019. Hence, the following resolution was passed unanimously.
