- 1. College ID Card and Hall ticket are mandatory for appearing in the examination. Halltickets will not be issued to debarred students.
- 2. The seating arrangement will be displayed on the Students notice board. Students should occupy their seats as per Exam Seat Number allotted to them.
- 3. The signature of the students in the signature sheet is compulsory.
- 4. Hall Tickets are to be printed & signed by the students from the student portal.
- 5. Students have to be seated 15 mins prior to the start of the examinations so as not to miss out on the supervisor instructions.
- 6. Warning Bell would be rung twice, first 10 mins prior to the start and second in the last 10 minutes of the exam.
- 7. Extra time or additional time will not be given for late comers.
- 8. Students who report to examination (30 minutes) post the beginning of the examination will not be permitted to appear for the said paper.
