IMPORTANT RULES

- 1.College ID Requirement: All participants must carry their college identity card and present it when requested.
- 2.Guidelines Compliance: Participants should review the guidelines provided along with the entry form thoroughly.
- 3.Entry Acceptance: The college reserves the right to cancel an event if there are fewer than 5 entries.
- 4.Player List: Only players listed with the entry fee are eligible to compete. Any replacements must be submitted with a letter from the College Principal.
- 5.Team Reporting: Teams must report one hour prior to their scheduled match.
- 6.Staff Cooperation: The cooperation of all staff members is essential for a smooth tournament and event execution.
- 7.Cultural Events Reporting: Participants in cultural events should report at least 30 minutes before their scheduled event.
8. Match Draws: Once finalized, match fixtures cannot be changed.
- 9.Singing Event: Singing participants must submit their song choice to the Event Coordinator by 21st December 2025. They must sing with a karaoke track, which they should bring to the event.
- 10.Cricket: Only 16 Teams will be allowed to participate. Registration is on a First Come, First Serve basis.

Awards & Recognition

Trophies and Certificates will be awarded to winners and runners-up in each event.



1. Tournament will be of Tennis Ball.
2. Match will be of 5 overs (over arm)
3. Team will consist of Class II, III and IV non-teaching staff members only. Non-Teaching Staff members of Self-Financing Courses can also participate.
4. A bowler will be permitted to bowl a maximum of 2 overs only. Four bowlers have to be used.
5. Team should bring their own kit.
6. Team should report thirty minutes before the commencement of the match.
7. Chasing the score is compulsory.
8. No arguments will be entertained, the Umpires' decision shall be final & binding.
9. List of team members along with their designation should be signed by the Principal.
10. Players should have their college Identity Card with them and produce them whenever asked for.
1. Players should wear sports T-Shirt.
2. A College can send only one team.
3. The decision of our team of experts relating to any differences in opinion will be final and binding to all the teams.
4. Objection should be lodged within an hour after the completion of the match. No objection will be entertained afterwards.
5. Matches will be held from Morning 8.00 a.m. to evening 5.00 p.m.
6. The Organisers retain rights to have any changes as required for smooth conduct of the Cricket Tournaments.
7. The tournament will be held on working days.
8. No request for change in fixture will be entertained.
9. Full name of the non-teaching staff members should be written on the entry form correctly.
10. Teams are requested not to exceed the time limit per inning otherwise will be penalized or may be debarred from this event as per the decision of the empires.

1. Each team shall consist of 6 players on court and 2 substitutes.
2. Matches will be played in best of 3 sets, each set up to 15 points (rally point system).
3. Overhand and underhand serves are allowed.
4. Substitution is allowed only when the ball is not in play.
5. Players are not allowed to touch the net or cross the center line during play.
6. In case of a tie, the final set will be played up to 15 points.

1. Matches will be played in knockout format.
2. Each match consists of 3 boards or 25 points, whichever comes first.

1. Tournament will follow the Swiss system or knockout format depending on entries.
2. Each match will have a time control of 30 minutes per player (or as announced).
3. Touch-move rule applies: once a piece is touched, it must be moved if legally possible.
4. Use of mobile phones or electronic devices during the game is strictly prohibited.
5. Players must record their moves if a scoresheet is provided.
6. In case of a tie, Buchholz system or blitz match will be used for deciding the winner.
